Animal Shelter Services



The City of Long Beach is entering into a new contract for Animal Shelter Services. The City circulated a Request for Proposal to regional Animal Services groups, with selection based upon expertise, business reputation and potential services to be offered.

Scope of Services offered:

General

- ✓ General duties of Animal Shelter in compliance with standards and methods applicable
- ✓ All animals surrendered by residents or seized by Animal Control Officers will be accepted into the shelter
- ✓ Shelter Database record-keeping regarding fostering, adoptions, medical and day-to-day care of animals
- ✓ Community awareness and education programs by promoting kindness to animals

Veterinary Services

- ✓ Vaccinations, spaying, neutering and general healthcare monitoring
- ✓ Basic Medical evaluation by Veterinarian of all animals
- ✓ SNAP and Heartworm testing
- ✓ Veterinary training and stocking of a pet food bank
- ✓ Provide animal training at shelter facility and bring in outside veterinarians in for training purposes

Adoption

- ✓ Adoptive Services with follow-up placement evaluations
- ✓ Meet with school and community groups to promote adoptions, proper care of pets, importance of community involvement in rescue and to provide further awareness of the Animal Shelter and kindness to animal practices

Posh Pets Rescue

The proper care of animals in Long Beach is of priority to the City, and Posh Pets Rescue has demonstrated a history of over 10 years of rescues in the New York area.
