Long Beach Clean Team: Keeping The Business District Clean & Litter Free

Long Beach residents have continually expressed a strong desire for sidewalks and gutters to be consistently kept clear and clean of litter, trash, and debris. Now, for the first time ever, City crews will be responsible for cleaning the downtown as part of the Long Beach Clean Team initiative, beginning July 1. Prior to this initiative, it was the responsibility of commercial property owners.



The Long Beach Clean Team will be in the business district sweeping streets, and clearing debris and litter from City sidewalks.

The Clean Team consists of City employees whose sole purpose is to keep the business districts along Park Avenue (from Monroe to Lafayette & Neptune to Roosevelt) and West Beech Street (from New York to Nevada) looking their best, keeping the City's downtown sections clean. City crews will be required to maintain and clean both sidewalks and gutters in these areas.

Clean Team Fees

Passed by the City Council at the May 17th, 2016 meeting, this new service will be covered by a Clean Team fee which is being charged to **commercial property owners in the business districts** on their tax bill. The property owners will be charged \$8 per front foot of real property owned on City tax bills July 1 as part of a six-month pilot program.

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Clean Team Fee Examples

-  A business with a front footage of 20', will be charged \$160 for the Clean Team fee.
-  A business with a front footage of 100', will be charged \$800 for the Clean Team fee.

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
