Re: Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Survey Forms

Dear Resident,

The City of Long Beach is applying for hazard mitigation funding through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funded by FEMA on behalf of our residents. If funded, this program will enable the City to assist homeowners with LONG TERM mitigation measures for future resiliency. Again, this would be a long term proactive solution to mitigate against future storms and is completely separate from the New York Rising program.

The HMGP is for residents who are interested in any of the following proactive measures:

1. Elevating their home
2. Elevating critical household systems (e.g., hot water heater, electrical panel)
3. Using storm-protective construction materials (e.g., hurricane straps, shutters)
4. Using flood resistant materials on their ground level

Once we collect all the necessary data and the full application is submitted, it will undergo a rigorous review process by New York State. If the City of Long Beach is awarded funds, we estimate funding would become available over the next one to four years.

We thank you for your interest in participating in the NYS Hazardous Mitigation Grant Program and greatly appreciate your assistance in collecting the necessary data to complete the application for New York State. Attached, please find two (2) forms New York State has requested to be completed by residents. Please note, these forms are strictly for data collection to complete the grant process and your information will never be shared. If the City of Long Beach is awarded this Hazard Mitigation Grant there is no obligation for you to participate. Additionally, below please find some frequently asked questions regarding the HMGP.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the difference between the HMGP and NY Rising?

The NY Rising program is a state grant program aimed at getting residents whose homes were impacted by Superstorm Sandy assistance in the short term, to help them return to their homes or repair the homes from damage caused directly by Superstorm Sandy.

The NYS Hazard Mitigation Program is a long term funding option and is geared toward taking preventative measures for the future. It is not a program that provides immediate assistance and the application process can be lengthy. If you already made repairs to your home and would like to do additional storm mitigation work, then this program may be of interest to you.

When will this funding be available?

The City of Long Beach is currently applying to the New York State for this funding. This funding has not yet been guaranteed to Long Beach. Once the full application is submitted it will undergo a rigorous review process. If the City of Long Beach is awarded funds, we estimate funding would become available over the next one to four years.

Why do you need residents to fill out the forms?

In order to complete the Hazard Mitigation Grant application it requires a tremendous amount of data regarding previous storms as well as damage sustained to residents' homes. The more accurate information we provide the better our chances are of receiving the funding.

If I fill out the forms am I obligated to participate in the HMGP?

Absolutely not, these forms are strictly for data collection to complete the grant process. If the City of Long Beach is awarded the grant you are absolutely not obligated to participate.
