1. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Purchase an Industrial Turn Mower.

The City Manager is authorized to purchase an Industrial Out Front 72” Deck Zero Turn Mower for the Beach Maintenance Department from All Island Equipment Corp, West Babylon, New York at a cost of \$12,204.72.

2. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into an Agreement for the Installation of Toddler Playground Equipment at the City’s Child Care Center with the Lowest Responsible Bidder and to Amend the Budget

The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Playsites Plus Surfaces, Inc., Central Islip, New York for the installation of toddler playground equipment at the Child Care Center located on Magnolia Boulevard, at a cost of \$61,692. Funds will be available in Account No. H1016.52331 (Recreation Improvements) after the following budget amendment is approved:

4. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into an Agreement for the Rehabilitation of 150 West Pine Street Municipal Building.

The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Milcon Construction Corporation, West Babylon, New York for the rehabilitation of 150 West Pine Street Municipal Building, at a cost of \$902,530.00.
