


SoBi Long Beach is a bike share program available to residents and visitors. It is a smart bike rental program that uses GPS to track and register bicycles. Users can rent the bikes via website, mobile app, at point-of-purchase kiosks or directly on the bikes themselves. When a user is done with a bike, it doesn't need to be returned to a hub at the end of the session. SoBi bikes can be locked up to any bike rack or one of the 7 hub locations. Two pricing plans are available: riders can pay either \$5 hourly or \$50 for the entire 2015 season. 


# City of Long Beach Summer Concessions Vendor Location

## Continuing to Enhance the Local Flavor

A wider variety of concession structures and vendors along the beach and boardwalk, providing residents more choices in more convenient locations. In addition to Riverside Boulevard the City will add a food truck at Edwards Blvd. We will be completing permanent bathroom locations on the boardwalk at Lincoln, Riverside, Edwards, National and Grand Boulevards.

The decision to place the type of structures in specific locations was based on feedback received during the boardwalk community outreach workshops that took place during last year's Long Beach Listens Boardwalk Phase II community outreach initiative.



# Beach Rules and Guidelines

**Chief of Lifeguards Paul Gillespie urges all beachgoers to take time to learn the Rules of the Beach. The more you know - the safer you will be. Swim only when lifeguards are on duty, and enjoy the beach! Contact the Beach Patrol at: 516-431-1810**

## Basic Rules of the Beach

- Learn to swim and never swim alone.
- Only swim when lifeguards are on duty.
- Always go to the beach with an adult and swim in front of the lifeguard between the green flags designated as the swimming area.
- If you are in trouble, call out for help & wave your arms above your head. Do not panic.
- Do not hesitate to call a lifeguard for help in any medical situation on the sand or in the water.
- Stay off the rock jetties and never swim near them.
- Check water conditions with lifeguards for undercurrents or sandbars. Both can be dangerous.
- Report dangerous situations to the lifeguard.
- Check the depth of underwater surface by jumping or walking, not diving head first!
- Do not attempt to make any rescue yourself. Get a lifeguard; they are trained to do the job. Do not interfere with lifeguards making a rescue.
- When you hear the whistle, look at the lifeguard chair. They may want your attention.
- Beaches close at 6:00pm. Swimming is prohibited when lifeguards are not on duty!

## For Your Safety, Please Remember:

- No alcoholic beverages on the beach or boardwalk.
- No bonfires or barbecues on the beach or on the boardwalk.
- Swimming is prohibited without a lifeguard on duty.**
- No dogs are permitted on the beach or boardwalk.
- No glass on the beach.

## Body Board Rules & Guidelines

- All Body Boards must have a leash cord attached. Leash cord must be used by the rider.
- All children must be watched by a parent or guardian.
- Flotation devices such as inflatable tubes and water wings are strictly prohibited.
- Body board use: It is at the discretion of the beach patrol to restrict body boards ( distance from shore, number permitted and rough water or other conditions.)
- Please listen to lifeguard's instructions.
- The use of body boards & surfboards in the same bathing area is prohibited.

*These Safety Regulations Have Been Established To Allow For The Enjoyment of Our Patrons. They In No Way Imply That The Use of Body Boards Or Surfboards Are Safe and Will Not Result In Injury.*

## Pool Safety Guidelines

- Completely fence in your pool on all four sides & keep it locked when unsupervised. Use self-closing, self-latching gates as part of fencing.
- Never leave a child unsupervised near a pool.
- Do not use flotation devices as a substitute for supervision.
- Never use a pool with its pool cover partially in place. Remove cover completely.
- Remove step to above ground pools when not in use.
- Have a telephone at pool side.
- Learn CPR and keep rescue equipment by pool.



# Ocean Beach Park Information

## Who is required to have a Beach Pass?

All those who have reached age 13 must have a beach pass to enter or remain on the beach on weekends from May 23 (including Memorial Day) through June 21 and daily from June 24 through Sept. 7. Non-residents are entitled to the same privileges as residents.

## Where can I buy season passes?

Season passes are on sale at the Gazebo located across from the Long Beach Ice Arena, at 150 West Bay Drive. The Gazebo will be open WEEKDAYS beginning May 2, 2015 from 9:00am until 6:00pm and WEEKENDS from 9:00am to 6:30pm until June 23, 2015. Beginning June 24 until July 6, 2015 seven days a week 9:00am - 4:00pm.

Season Passes will also be on sale at the Beach Trailer at the southwest corner of Laurelton Blvd. and West Broadway. The Beach trailer will be open WEEKENDS ONLY from Saturday, May 23, 2015 (including Memorial Day) through Sunday, June 21, 2015 from 9:00am to 4:00pm. Passes will be sold DAILY from Monday, June 22, 2015 through Labor Day, Monday, September 7, 2015 from 9:00am until 4:00pm.

## Is there a family discount?

Yes. Family Season passes include 2 adult passes & passes for those children living in the household between the ages of 13 and 17. Children 12 & under are free and children 18 & older are considered adults. Proof of birth date must be presented at the time of purchase.

*Children born after September 7, 2002 will not need a beach pass in the summer of 2015 and those born before May 25, 1997 will need to purchase an adult pass.*

## Is there a further discount for Long Beach Residents?

Yes. City of Long Beach Residents pay \$60 for passes for the whole family for the entire season while those not living in Long Beach will enjoy the same privilege for \$120.

## What do I need to provide?

Residency: Those wishing to purchase season passes at the resident rate must have an address in the City of Long Beach. The following forms of proof are acceptable. Driver's license with Long Beach address, check or bill or lease with Long Beach address and picture ID.

Resident Child: A resident child pass will be issued when proof of age is presented via birth certificate or passport or some other acceptable form of identification.

Senior Citizen: Driver's license or passport indicating birth date on or before May 25, 1953.

Physically Challenged: Documentation indicating physical disability. Military Rate: U.S. Government ID indicating holder is a member or has been honorably discharged from a branch of the United States Armed Services.

## Where can I purchase daily passes?

Daily admission tickets will be sold to all adults and children who have reached their thirteenth (13) birthday at the rate of \$12.00 per day. Locations for the sale of daily admission tickets are on the boardwalk at Neptune Blvd., Franklin Blvd., Lincoln Blvd., Monroe Blvd., Long Beach Blvd., Riverside Blvd., Edwards Blvd., Lafayette Blvd., New York Ave. and at the beach entrances on Pacific Blvd., Long Beach Blvd. & National Blvd.

## Are discount daily passes available?

Yes, economy passes with (10) admissions are available for \$80 (a \$40 savings). They may be used by one individual or several.

## What if I lose my pass?

We are sorry, but beach passes will not be replaced or refunded under any circumstances. Lost passes, if found, will be returned.

## Are there accommodations for the physically challenged?

Yes, the City of Long Beach has a newly rebuilt boardwalk that is equipped with an ADA compliant ramp at every street. Additionally, all of the dune walkovers are ADA compliant both to the East and West. Surf Chairs for the physically challenged are available by contacting Lifeguard Headquarters at 431-1810. Beach Patrol personnel will bring one to you. Roll-out ramps are sometimes placed at various beaches so you can easily go right down to the surf line.

## Can I get there by train?

The Long Island Rail Road station is steps away from our beaches. Special LIRR Get-A-Way Packages which include Train Fare & Beach Park Admission Ticket are available at the following LIRR ticket booths:

# Department of Parks and Recreation



The City of Long Beach Parks and Recreation Department offers something for everyone including recreation programs, athletics, adult leagues, fitness groups, special events as well as passive recreation at one of our seven playgrounds. The Recreation Campus includes an indoor municipal pool, ice arena, turf fields, basketball courts, roller hockey rink, fishing pier, boat launch and boardwalk promenade. A brand new state-of-the-art skate community designed skate park is being built and will open this summer. The dog run is temporarily closed due to the construction. This department also oversees the Beach Park (see page 14.) We are located at 700 Magnolia Boulevard (Magnolia Boulevard and the bay).



### ADMISSION & HOURS

The Recreation Center is open seven days a week. Members are required to check in at the front desk upon arrival each time they use the facility or pay the daily admission rate. Membership entitles unlimited use of the facility including, weight room, cardio room, steam room, locker room and pool.

Membership passes for residents and non-residents are available annually, semi-annually, for three months or monthly. Daily admission for the Pool and or Fitness Center is as follows: Adult (18 & over) \$8.00; child, senior citizen, physically challenged \$4.00. Residents may sign up to use the facility for \$25 per month indefinitely (\$15 for seniors and children under 18).

### FITNESS CENTER

Fitness at the Rec has never been better. If you're looking to lose weight, get strong or just stay healthy, the Rec has what you need. With a designated cardiovascular room and separate weight room you can achieve all your fitness goals. There are treadmills, elliptical machines, stationary bikes, an arm bike and a stationary rower to get your heart rate pumping. We have a complete Cybex circuit of weight machines as well as free weights and cable stations to challenge your muscles. We offer an Adult Fitness Class that can help you learn how to use all of the equipment, or join for 6 months or more and receive a free personal orientation with our Exercise Physiologist.

Every week day, weather permitting, during the summer, the fun will rotate from park to park. # Parks and Recreation Facilities

### PLAYGROUND FACILITIES

Playground facilities are located at \*Georgia Ave and West Beech St, Magnolia Boulevard and the Boardwalk, Pacific Blvd. and Shore Rd. (closed for renovations). \*Park Place and West Hudson St, \*Clark St at Reynolds Channel, Riverside Blvd. and E Pine St, Veterans' Park located on Magnolia Boulevard and West Bay Drive. (\*) Indicates that the playground is equipped with a water spray component that is active in the summer when weather permits.



### VETERANS PARK

The Waterfront Park is located at Magnolia Boulevard and the bay. It includes a Children's Playground, Basketball Courts, Roller Hockey Rink, Boat Ramp with parking spaces for Boat Trailer/Car, Fishing Pier, Jogging Paths, Bayfront promenade and bathroom facilities. The Ocean Beach Park Office is also located here in the park gazebo.



### BOAT LAUNCH

The Municipal Boat Launch located on the bay at National Boulevard is open during the summer from 8am to 8pm. There is a 15 minute limit per vessel. No vessels may exceed 25 feet in length; no repairs or mooring; no cleaning & washing of vessels; no jet skis or wave runners. Swimming is prohibited.

### SKATE PARK

Located on National Boulevard at the bay. The park is under construction and will open later this summer.

### DOG RUN

The dog run, located on National Boulevard overlooking Reynolds Channel is currently closed while the skate park is under construction.



### FISHING PIER

The municipal fishing pier is located on Magnolia Boulevard overlooking Reynolds Channel. Come down and enjoy fishing with a beautiful view of the Manhattan skyline. It is open from 6am to 10pm daily.



### BILLY CRYSTAL-NANCY LIEBERMAN BASKETBALL DREAM COURTS

Long Beach native Billy Crystal and Basketball Hall of Famer Nancy Lieberman teamed up to build brand new basketball courts. ## Which Dogs Must Be Licensed?

 Every dog owned or harbored in New York State for longer than 30 days must be licensed.

 All dogs harbored within the City of Long Beach must have a City of Long Beach Dog License.

*A metal tag is issued which is to be attached to the dog's collar.*

*Please note: No refunds will be made after a license has been validated.*

# Schedule of Surfing Beaches 2015

All surfers must pay admission to the Beach Park and are subject to all Beach Park and Beach Patrol rules and regulations.

## DESIGNATED SURFING AREAS, HOURS, AND YELLOW FLAG MARKERS

Continuing the successful policy from prior years, Surfing Beaches, Limited Hours Surfing Beaches, and other areas that are open to surfing will be marked clearly with yellow flags by the City of Long Beach Lifeguards, serving to visually notify residents and visitors where surfing is permitted. Beaches designated as "All Hours" shall be open to surfing at all times, 7 days a week. Beaches designated as "Limited Hours" shall be open to surfing until 12 noon, 7 days a week.

Surfers are hereby instructed that when the yellow flags are taken down on a limited hours beach, surfing in that area has ended and they must exit the water promptly. Lifeguards shall give a 10 minute warning prior to taking the flags down to indicate when surfing hours are ending. Surfers on any beach who fail to exit the water or promptly paddle or walk to an adjacent surfing beach when instructed by lifeguards or other beach park personnel shall be subject to fines.

## PERMANENT SURFING BEACHES - Seven Days A Week - All Hours

Surfing is permitted 7 days a week on the following beaches:

Lincoln Blvd. to Monroe Blvd.

Maple Blvd. to Pacific Blvd. to the East of the swimming area.


