The City has hired 30 Summer Special Officers to enforce quality of life violations in and around the beach park. This includes ensuring compliance with possessing a beach pass.

We have an overt and covert operation. The overt operation includes beach sweeps in the morning to make sure that people who arrived before 9:00A.M. have a beach pass. There will also be regular beach sweeps throughout the day to find

those who may have entered the beach without a pass. The ticket takers and Summer Special Officers will work under the direction of an on-site supervisor who is a retired police inspector, working out of beach park trailer on Laurelton Blvd. and Broadway. He will coordinate this operation to further ensure full compliance with all beach park regulation.

Please tell your family and friends to comply with these sweeps to make it a pleasurable experience for all but violators.
