1. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into a Contract for Emergency Sanitary Sewer Replacement at Riverside Boulevard between East Hudson Street and East Fulton Street

The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Macedo Contracting Services, Inc., Ronkonkoma, New York for emergency sanitary sewer replacement on Riverside Boulevard between East Hudson Street and East Fulton Street, at a cost of \$130,700.00.

2. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Purchase Software Services Under New York State Contract and to Transfer Funds

3. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into an Agreement for the Upgrade of the Police Department Locker Room and Bathroom and to Build a Dispatch Communication Center with the Lowest Responsible Bidder

The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with AFL General Construction, Farmingdale, New York for the upgrade of the Police Department locker room and bathroom, and the building of a Dispatch Communication Center, inclusive of demolition, plumbing, electric and HVAC work, at a cost of \$484,100.00.
