1. Local Law Amending Subpart C of Related Acts Relating to the Charter of the City of Long Beach Re: A Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit Established in General Municipal Law § 3-c

5. Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Manager to Furnish and Install a Gasboy System, Gas and Diesel Fuel Pumps and an Automatic Tank Gauge Under Nassau County Contract

The Acting City Manager is authorized to furnish and install a gasboy system, gas and diesel fuel pumps and an automatic tank gauge from Global Fueling Systems, Inc., West Babylon, New York under Nassau County Department of Public Works Contract #BPNC20000205 through November 17, 2023, for a cost of \$95,032.63.

Item 2. Hydrated Lime Bulk – Graymont Inc., Bellefonte, PA at a bid price of \$251.33 per ton.

7. Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Manager to Purchase a Dri-Prime Dewatering Pump from the Sole Responsible Bidder
