1. Local Law Amending Subpart C of Related Acts Relating to the Charter of the City of Long Beach Re: A Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit Established in General Municipal Law § 3-c.

The Capital Improvement Program for the five-year period from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2026, inclusive, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk, be and the same is hereby adopted.

4. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into an Inter-Municipal Cooperation Agreement with the County of Nassau to Receive Funding for the Purchase of an Office Trailer and Related Items

The City Manager is authorized to enter into an Inter-Municipal Cooperation Agreement with the County of Nassau for the above said project. The City Council adopts this resolution making a SEQRA environmental determination that the proposed Inter-Municipal Cooperation Agreement and Project will not have a significant effect on the environment and issues a negative declaration.

5. Ordinance Authorizing a Modification to the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Long Beach and the Long Beach Civil Service Employees Association

The City Manager is authorized to enter into an Agreement to modify the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Long Beach Civil Service Employees Association, effective through June 30, 2025, and to file said Agreement in the Office of the City Clerk.

6. Ordinance to Schedule a Special Meeting of the City Council for Monday, May 24, 2021, Authorizing the Adoption of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year Commencing July 1, 2021 and Ending June 30, 2022, Appropriating Sums Set Forth Therein and Determining and Fixing the Real Estate Tax Levy

7. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Accept and Execute a Grant on Behalf of the City of Long Beach from the New York State Department of State.

The City Manager is authorized to sign legal documents on behalf of the City of Long Beach and that such signature is acknowledgement of the acceptance by the City of Long Beach of compliance with all terms and conditions of Contract #C1000947 to be executed for the grant with the New York State Department of State. The City Council adopts this resolution making a SEQRA environmental determination that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and issues a negative declaration. The City of Long Beach agrees that it has \$350,000 available for the City match in Account No. H1018.52344 (Park Avenue Resiliency) and that it will provide funding equal to the balance of \$925,000 necessary to satisfy the City's match of the grant award; which balance is included in the 2021-2026 Capital Improvement Program to be funded through future borrowing.
