The following Resolution was moved by

Resolution Authorizing the Adoption of the Operating Budget for the Fiscal Year Commencing July 1, 2023 and Ending June 30, 2024, Appropriating Sums Set Forth Therein and Determining and Fixing the Real Estate Tax Levy.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York, as follows:

Sec. 1. The Operating Budget of the City of Long Beach for fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024, providing for the expenditure of \$102,992,626 and the Personnel Schedule, all of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are in all respects adopted, confirmed, fixed and determined.

Sec. 2. The sums of money designated in the Operating Budget as appropriations for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024, and the sums of money set forth for debt service and capital outlay are hereby appropriated and authorized to be expended for debt service and current expenses of the departments, agencies and purposes enumerated therein, in such manner as may be provided by law.

Sec. 3. The amount of real estate taxes required in addition to such other current revenues and other receipts is hereby determined to be \$59,875,905. The rate of tax required to produce such amount is determined to be \$24.8164 per \$100 assessed valuation, as shown on the Assessment Roll last completed for Homesteading properties, and \$43.7716 per \$100 of assessed valuation as shown on the Assessment Roll last completed for non-Homesteading properties. The said Assessment Roll is in all respects confirmed.

Sec. 4. The City Council hereby directs that the said amount be levied and raised by an ad valorem tax on all of the taxable property in the City according to the valuation on the last completed Assessment Roll.

Sec. 5. The Acting City Manager is hereby directed to cause the amount heretofore directed to be levied and raised, and to extend such tax and issue the warrant required by law for the collection of same.

Sec. 6. The Acting City Manager is hereby authorized to allocate the expending and/or encumbering of appropriations on a monthly, quarterly or other basis to assure availability of appropriations throughout the fiscal year.

Sec. 7. This Resolution shall be determined to repeal any inconsistent provision of the personnel schedule or roster.

Sec. 8. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Manager to Enter into an Agreement for the Replacement of Outdoor Condenser Water Piping & Insulation at the Magnolia Senior & Child Day Care Center.

WHEREAS, the City discovered that the outdoor condenser water piping that serves the air conditioning system at the Magnolia Senior & Child Day Care Center, 650 Magnolia Boulevard, Long Beach, New York is leaking; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works identified a potential contractor to replace the outdoor condenser water piping & insulation at the Magnolia Senior & Child Day Care Center, 650 Magnolia Boulevard, Long Beach, New York; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase and have installed new piping and hardware for hangers and thermal insulation from Premier Mechanical Services Inc., 1493 Church Street, Holbrook, New York 11741, at a cost of \$87,325.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the Acting City Manager be and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Premier Mechanical Services Inc., 1493 Church Street, Holbrook, New York 11741 for the purchase and installation of a new piping and hardware for hangers and thermal insulation to replace the outdoor condenser water piping & insulation at the Magnolia Senior & Child Day Care Center, 650 Magnolia Boulevard, Long Beach, New York, at a cost of \$87,325.00, under Suffolk County Contract #ACRI022323S, valid through February 22, 2024. Funds in the amount of \$70,000.00 are available in Account No. H1022.52134 (Magnolia Senior Center Improvement), funds in the amount of \$10,623.00 are available in Account No. H1015.52286 (Building Recon – Magnolia Senior Center) and funds in the amount of \$6,702.00 are available in Account No. H1018.52349 (Various Building Improvements).

Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Manager to Enter into a
Contract for Emergency Sanitary Sewer Replacement on Curley Street
between East Pine Street and East Chester Street.

WHEREAS, emergency repairs and replacement are required on Curley Street
between East Pine Street and East Chester Street due to a sanitary sewer main collapse; and

WHEREAS, five bids were received in the Office of the Commissioner of Public
Works on Thursday, May 18, 2023 for the replacement of approximately 235 linear feet of
collapsed sanitary sewer pipe, including complete restoration of pavement; and

WHEREAS, A.I.I. Allen Industries, 510 Broadway, Amityville, New York 11701
was the lowest responsible bidder at a cost of \$234,825.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York
that the Acting City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a contract with A.I.I.
Allen Industries, 510 Broadway, Amityville, New York 11701, for emergency sanitary sewer
pipe replacement and pavement restoration on Curley Street between East Pine Street and East
Chester Street, at a cost of \$234,825.00. Funds in the amount of \$133,804.00 are available in
Account No. H3021.52358 (Sewer Upgrades Compliance) and funds in the amount of
\$101,021.00 are available in Account No. H3017.52358 (Sewer Upgrades Compliance).
