CITY OF LONG BEACH  
MEETING OF JULY 2, 2024**

Present: Council President Finn and Council Members Bendo, Fiumara, Lester, and Reinhart.

1. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Accept a Grant.

The City Manager is authorized to accept the grant of \$70,000.00 from Empire State Development, to be used to fund the development of a parking study that focuses on parking needs in the West End, Park Avenue Central Business District, and East End. The total amount of funds authorized to be expended for receipt of the grant award funds, in the total amount of \$150,000.00, will be available upon borrowing completed at a later date pursuant to Bond Ordinance #3090/24.

2. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Purchase Fire Department Software

The City Manager is authorized to purchase for dispatching, paging and other services, with specified options, from Island Tech Services, Ronkonkoma, NY at a cost of \$26,501.64 for a term of one year.

3. Resolution Authorizing the Corporation Counsel to Execute a Settlement Agreement and Release

The Corporation Counsel is authorized to execute a Settlement Agreement and Release with Louis Alfasi, with prejudice, for which the City will pay \$40,427.26 to Louis Alfasi for fiscal year 2024-2025, and for the difference of Louis Alfasi's "current regular salary and wages" and New York State annual pension benefit per year until Mr. Alfasi reaches the mandatory age of retirement as set forth in General Municipal Law § 207-a (2). Said agreement shall contain such other terms and conditions as deemed appropriate by the Corporation Counsel.

The remaining funds donated by John A. Carbona, amounting to \$33,842.15 shall continue to be reserved for future Lifeguard Departmental operations.
