Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into  
an Agreement for the Rental and Installation of Air  
Conditioning Equipment for the Long Beach Police Department.

WHEREAS, the air conditioning system located in the Long Beach Police Department is not functioning, having outlived its useful life and it has been determined that the excessive heat, at times exceeding 90 degrees, constitutes an emergency situation, affecting the health, welfare and/or safety of the City's Police staff, as well as members of the public that enter the precinct; and

WHEREAS, the City has begun the process to have the entire system redesigned and replaced, but it will not be completed for this summer season; and

WHEREAS, due to the nature of this emergency procurement, the City has solicited quotes from multiple vendors in compliance with the City's Procurement Policy, for the rental of air conditioning equipment, to include the mobilization of the equipment and the installation of the necessary duct work; and

WHEREAS, the quote that best meets the needs of the City and was the lowest was submitted by Garner, The Emergency Response Company, 1717 W. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Deer Park, Texas 77536, for the mobilization, installation and rental of a 40 ton air conditioning unit and the installation of the necessary duct work, for a period of twelve weeks, at a total cost of \$46,436.60;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that an emergency exists due to the excessive heat in the City's Police Department building which seriously threatens the public health, welfare and/or safety, thereby requiring an immediate need for materials, supplies and services; and be it further

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into an agreement with Garner, The Emergency Response Company, 1717 W. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Deer Park, Texas 77536 for the mobilization, installation and rental of a 40 ton air conditioning unit and the installation of the necessary duct work, for a period of twelve weeks, at a total cost of \$46,436.60.
