6. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Purchase Towels and Tissues from the Lowest Responsible Bidders

The City Manager is authorized to purchase from the following lowest responsible bidders in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the City Purchasing Agent, on an “as needed” basis for a period of one year, towels and tissue, as per bid:

APPCO Paper & Plastics Corp., Island Park, New York– Georgia Pacific 7-7/8” wide, 1,150 feet long Kraft Rolled Towels “or equal” at a cost of \$19.89 per case; and

Imperial Bag & Paper Co., South Jersey City, New Jersey– Captiva 2-Ply Junior Jumbo Toilet Tissue “or equal” at a cost of \$15.21 per case and Nibroc White Facial Tissue “or equal” at a cost of \$15.65 per case; and

United Sales USA Corp., Brooklyn, New York– Sunshine MFW Multifold Towels “or equal” at a cost of \$17.67 per case and Nittany Ultra Roll Tissue 12 Jumbo Roll 1-Ply Toilet Tissue “or equal” at a cost of \$21.50 per case; and

J & F Supply of Long Island, Inc., Long Beach, New York– Elegant 2-Ply Rolled Paper Towels “or equal” at a cost of \$18.00 per case, Kruger White Swan C-Fold Towels “or equal” 10” x 13” at a cost of \$19.50 per case, and Georgia Pacific 3,000 sheets, 1-Ply Toilet Tissue 5-3/4” wide “or equal” at a cost of \$37.10 per case.
