Various Sized Trash Bags from the Lowest Responsible Bidders.

WHEREAS, after due advertisement therefore, five (5) complete bids were received in the Office of the City Purchasing Agent on Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 2:30 p.m., for the purchase of various sized trash bags, as per specifications on file in the Office of the City Purchasing Agent to be used by Beach Maintenance, Street Maintenance, Municipal Building, Recreation and Sanitation, and the following named firms were the lowest responsible bidders in each instance;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the Acting City Manager be and is hereby authorized to purchase various sized trash bags from the following lowest responsible bidders in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the City Purchasing Agent, for a period of one year with an option to renew for one additional year, upon mutual consent of the parties, as per bid:

Interboro Packaging Corp., 114 Bracken Road, Montgomery, New York 12549 – approximately 100 cases of 30” x 36” 2ML black bags; approximately 500 cases of 40” x 48” 3ML black bags and approximately 50 cases of 33” x 40” 2ML clear bags; and

Imperial Bag & Paper Co., 225 Route 1 & 9, South Jersey City, New Jersey 07306 – approximately 50 cases of 40” x 48” 3ML clear bags; and

Unipak, 88 Cooper Avenue, West Long Branch, New Jersey 07764 – approximately 100 cases of 24” x 33” 6 Micron clear bags.
