WHEREAS, Ferguson Waterworks, 200 Atlantic Avenue, New Hyde Park, New York 11040 was the lowest responsible bidder for the one-time purchase of 24 Mueller Super Centurion Hydrants Model A423, or equal, at the following prices: the 3 foot bury at a cost of \$2,279.50; the 3 ½ foot bury at a cost of \$2,234.07; the 4 ½ foot bury at a cost of \$2,403.44; and the 5 foot bury at a cost of \$2,586.49, for a total cost of \$57,755.35;

WHEREAS, after due advertising therefore, one bid was received in the Office of the City Purchasing Agent on Thursday, September 23, 2021 for Radio System Maintenance used primarily by the City's Fire and Police Departments, as well as Sanitation, Street, and Building Depts., as per specifications on file in the Office of the City Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, Multi-Media Communications, 190 Adams Avenue, Hauppauge, New York 11788 has provided this service for the past twenty seven years and was the sole responsible bidder at a monthly cost of \$300.00 for emergency service for base stations and ancillary equipment; a labor rate of \$72.00 per hour for all mobile radios plus parts; a 10% discount on manufacturer's parts and materials; and a 20% mark-up over cost where no list price is available;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

WHEREAS, after due advertisement therefore, three (3) bids were received in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works on July 29, 2021 for the installation of an enclosure over the open air treatment basins at the City's Water Treatment Plant, in accordance with plans and specifications on file in the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the City's engineering consultants reviewed the bids and checked the references in the bid documents and recommend awarding the project to the lowest responsible bidder, R. J. Industries, Inc., 75 East Bethpage Road, PO Box 349, Plainview, New York 11803, at a cost of \$993,700;

Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Accept
Funds from the New York State Municipal Workers'
Compensation Alliance.

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach is a member of the New York State Municipal Workers' Compensation Alliance (Comp Alliance), a not-for-profit workers' compensation group self-insurance program for municipalities and school districts, with a focus on improving workplace safety and providing stable funding for its members; and

WHEREAS, in appreciation of its members, Comp Alliance is distributing a portion of its surplus to its members; and

WHEREAS, this monetary award reflects a recognition by the Comp Alliance Board of Trustees of fiscal challenges faced by municipalities and provides a benefit of municipal cooperation by returning funds to local governments and schools; and

WHEREAS, Comp Alliance has advised the City that we are receiving an award in the amount of \$42,498.00;

Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute an Agreement with the County of Nassau for the Operation of Bus Service by the City of Long Beach Between Point Lookout, Lido Beach and the Long Beach Long Island Rail Road Station.

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has provided bus service between the City of Long Beach and Point Lookout for almost four decades; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach and the County of Nassau desire to continue the operation of bus service between the communities of Point Lookout, Lido Beach and the Long Beach Long Island Rail Road Station; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement became effective January 1, 2018 and terminates December 31, 2021, with an annual payment of \$75,000; and

WHEREAS, prior to renewal of this Agreement, the City Manager and the County shall agree on the amount of consideration to be paid to the City as full consideration for the City's performance of services;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the County of Nassau for bus service between Point Lookout, Lido Beach and the Long Beach Long Island Rail Road Station, from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2021 for which the County of Nassau has agreed to pay the City of Long Beach the sum of \$75,000 for each year; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said agreement shall contain such other terms and conditions as the City Manager and the Corporation Counsel shall deem proper.
