A Bond Ordinance Authorizing Financing for Various Capital Projects in and for the City, Stating the Estimated Total Cost Thereof is \$11,296,749, Appropriating Said Amount Therefor, Including the Expenditure of Any State or Federal Aid Expected to be Received in Connection Therewith, and Authorizing the Issuance of Not to Exceed \$8,377,000 Bonds of Said City to Finance a Portion of Said Appropriation; and Further Authorizing Any Amounts Received from the United States of America and/or the State of New York to be Expended Towards the Cost of Certain of Such Capital Projects as Indicated Herein, or Redemption of any Notes and Bonds Issued Therefor or to be Budgeted as an Offset to the Taxes for Payment of the Principal of and Interest on Said Notes and Bonds was passed by four affirmative votes (Council Member Lester voted no) and is published elsewhere in this edition.

5. A “Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments to the Community Development Fund for the 45<sup>th</sup> Program Year” was taken off the calendar

6. Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into a Contract for the Hauling of Undigested Sludge from the City’s Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Clear River Environmental Service Corp., Ronkonkoma, New York for the providing of five thousand (5,000) gallon unibody trucks for the transport of undigested sludge from the City’s Wastewater Treatment Plant, to the South Shore Reclamation Facility, East Rockaway, New York, at a unit price of \$899 per 5,000 gallon truck, for a six month initial term, at an estimated cost of \$350,610, with one additional six month option if necessary.

7. Resolution Authorizing Publication for Hearing of a Local Law Amending the Charter of the City of Long Beach Re: Assessment; Levy; Collection of Taxes.

**Summary:** This local law adds the following to Charter Sec. 104-d – “**All medical and prescription expenses which are not reimbursed or paid by insurance shall be excluded from the computation of an applicant’s income**”
