Development Funds budget, equaling \$600,000, upon full execution of the grant contract with  
Nassau County;

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has been awarded a grant of \$300,000.00 from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for a term of three years, for the hiring of a new Detective and creation of a Narcotics Division for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach is a Municipal Corporation and pursuant to Section 3 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach, the City may accept said grant;

New York 11561 was the most responsible proposer, in that the proposal best fits the needs of  
the City, with a proposal to pay an annual rental fee of \$12,500.00 to the City for the opportunity  
to operate the Snack Bar;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 12/24, the City entered into an agreement with Roadwork Ahead, Inc., 2186 Kirby Lane, Syosset, New York for the for the improvement of walkability, accessibility, safety, streetscape and beautification, as well as to replace curbs, sidewalks, and street lighting, and planting of new trees for West Park Avenue Riverside Boulevard to Long Beach Road, also known as the Downtown Resilient Connectivity for West Park Avenue Riverside Boulevard to Long Beach Road Project Phase II; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 12/24, the Capital Projects Fund Budget must be amended to increase budgeted revenue and expense amounts in the Capital Projects Fund pertaining to the Downtown Resilient Connectivity for West Park Avenue Riverside Boulevard to Long Beach Road Project Phase II, once grant reimbursement is received by the City;
