Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into a
Contract for Masonry Work at Various Locations Throughout

WHEREAS, after due advertisement therefore, three bids were received in the
Office of the Commissioner of Public Works on August 2, 2018 for “as-needed” masonry work
at quantities and at unit prices in accordance with plans and specifications on file in the Office of
the Commissioner of Public Works, which fall outside the normal scope and availability of the
City’s in-house staff; and

WHEREAS, said work shall include, but not be limited to, 4” sidewalks at a unit
price of \$7.49 per square foot; 6” sidewalk ramps at a unit price of \$9.49 per square foot; 6”
driveway ramps at a unit price of \$9.00 per square foot and the excavation and restoration of
roadways at a unit price of \$8.00 per square foot; and

WHEREAS, Stasi Industries, 303 Winding Road, Old Bethpage, New York
11804 was the lowest responsible bidder at the above stated unit prices;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the
City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a contract with Stasi Industries, 303
Winding Road, Old Bethpage, New York 11804 for “as-needed” masonry work at unit prices in
accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works, for a
period of one year at a cost not to exceed \$148,535.53, with an option to extend said contract for
an additional year under the same terms and conditions. Funds in the amount of \$31,745.01 are
available in Account No. H1015.52260 (Capital-Rehabilitation of Curb/Sidewalk Citywide),
funds in the amount of \$16,790.52 are available in Account No. H1017.53061 (Capital-Curb
Replacement Citywide) and funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 are available in Account No.
H1019.53061 (Capital-Curb Replacement Citywide).

Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into a Contract for Asphalt Overlay Work at Various Locations throughout the City on an “As-Needed” Basis with the Lowest Responsible Bidder.

WHEREAS, after due advertisement therefore, three bids were received in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works on August 30, 2018 for “as-needed” asphalt overlay work at various locations throughout the City, in accordance with unit pricing for specific work, as per specifications on file in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, this resolution will allow for the resurfacing of various roadways throughout the City to provide smoother riding surfaces and improved runoff conditions; and

WHEREAS, Roadwork Ahead, Inc., 2186 Kirby Lance, Syosset, New York 11791 was the lowest responsible bidder as per specifications on file in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works and they have successfully provided this service to the City for several years;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a contract with Roadwork Ahead, Inc., 2186 Kirby Lance, Syosset, New York 11791 for “as-needed” asphalt overlay work in accordance with unit pricing for specific work for a period of one year at a cost not to exceed \$413,378.50, with an option to extend said contract for an additional year under the same terms and conditions. Funds in the amount of \$13,378.50 are available in Account No. H1017.52299 (Road Overlays) and funds in the amount of \$400,000.00 are available in Account No. H1019.52299 (Road Overlays).

Resolution Authorizing the Use of Funds from the City
of Long Beach Relief Fund.

WHEREAS, every year during the winter holiday season, the City adorns the trees in front of City Hall with lights as well as numerous street light poles along Park Avenue, West Beech Street and the Boardwalk with strings of lights and ornamental light fixtures attached to the poles; and

WHEREAS, many of these lights, fixtures, brackets and other appurtenances were inundated with salt water in their storage unit during Superstorm Sandy and in the years following the storm, the City has cleaned up the rust and decay and used them, but now finds that many of these items are beyond cleaning and repair, and have outlived their useful lives;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to purchase strings of lights, replacement light bulbs for the ornamental fixtures, brackets and other appurtenances needed to hang these lights for the winter holiday season, at a cost of \$16,410.47. Funds are available in Account No. P1000.54701 (City of Long Beach Relief Fund).
