WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Council an application pursuant to Section 9-112(18)(c) of Appendix A (Zoning Law) of the Long Beach Code of Ordinances, for waiver of off-street parking requirements for the premises located at 143 East Park Avenue (street floor), Long Beach, New York (Section 59, Block 109, Lot 20) between Long Beach and Riverside Boulevards, having frontage of 20 feet, on behalf of the owner Darren Gallo, 143 East Park Avenue, Long Beach, New York 11561 to be used as an Early Childhood Center – Play Gym; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on this date;

NOW, THEREFORE, after due deliberation, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York, that the application of the owner Darren Gallo, 143 East Park Avenue, Long Beach, New York 11561 for exemption with respect to the requirements for off-street parking at premises 143 East Park Avenue (street floor), having frontage of 20 feet, be and the same hereby is granted, only and during the time that such premises shall be used as an Early Childhood Center – Play Gym.

defibrillator to replace an outdated defibrillator; and

WHEREAS, Physio-Control, Inc., 11811 Willows Road NE, Richmond,
Washington 98073 is the sole source provider for said equipment, at a cost of \$28,634.55; and

WHEREAS, the City can obtain financing for this purchase from Physio-Control,
Inc., for a period of five years, at an annual payment of \$6,213.83;

City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to purchase one Lifepak 15 cardiac monitor/
