

**CITY OF LONG BEACH
MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
HELD DECEMBER 18TH, 2020**

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Long Beach was held on Friday, December 18th, 2020.

Present were Council President Bendo and Council Members Delury, Mandel, McInnis and Treston.

Deputy Corporation Counsel Richard Berrios and City Manager Donna Gayden were also present.

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, public attendance was suspended for this meeting. The following notice was posted prior to the meeting:

The calendar items were read by the City Clerk

#1 – Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into a Contract for Emergency Sanitary Sewer Replacement on the East Side of Lindell Boulevard between West Park Avenue and West Walnut Street from the Lowest Responsible Bidder.

Commissioner John Mirando spoke about the sewer main that collapsed on Lindell Boulevard between West Park and West Walnut Street. He noted that it was a tenant sewer line and bypass pumping had begun in order to avoid any other backups in the system. Mr. Mirando continued to explain further procedures that would take place to remedy this situation. He also spoke about the urgency of this resolution.

Council Member Treston asked where the new manhole cover would be located.

Mr. Mirando replied that this manhole cover is replacing the manhole at the same location.is currently.

Council Member Delury noted that this type of work was difficult.

Commissioner Mirando noted that some main replacement could be done by city staff, but once it gets below five feet, the city does not have the proper equipment to complete the job.

The voting portion of the meeting was then begun.

Council Member Mandel introduced and moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Pres. Bendo, and it was duly adopted, all five council members present voting in the affirmative.
