Long Beach Junior Lifeguard Code of Conduct It is our desire, that all Long Beach Junior Lifeguards will display behavior that reflects the ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and a sense of fair play. The benefits of being a Long Beach Junior Lifeguard should be stressed, and any action that tends to destroy those values should be discouraged. Courtesy should be shown toward fellow Long Beach Junior Lifeguards, Instructors, and Supervisors. Efforts must be made to achieve a thorough understanding and acceptance of the rules of the Junior Lifeguard program. It is important for all, to recognize that the purpose of Junior Lifeguards, is to promote the physical, mental, moral, social, and emotional well-being of the individual Junior Lifeguard.

Long Beach Junior Lifeguards are expected to:

1. Conduct themselves in a mature fashion at all times.
2. Not encourage bullying of any kind (including social media) toward other Junior Lifeguards or Instructors.
3. Avoid the use of profanity, abusive language, or inappropriate gestures in dealing with ALL MEMBERS OF THE PROGRAM AND PUBLIC.
4. Set an example, in word and action, both on and off the beach.
5. Remember that Junior Lifeguards assume a leadership role and that younger beachgoers may emulate their behavior.

All Junior Lifeguards are expected to behave responsibly while participating in the program.
