

Proclamation Extending Previously Declared Local State of Emergency

DONNA M. GAYDEN, City Manager of the City of Long Beach, County of Nassau, State of New York, pursuant to the power vested in her by Section 20 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach and the laws of the State of New York, including Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law to preserve the public safety and render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of Long Beach, hereby exercises that authority as follows:

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2020, Governor Cuomo issued Executive Order Number 202 declaring a State disaster emergency for the entire State of New York; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the novel Coronavirus to be a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County Executive Curran declared a State of Emergency for the County of Nassau, effective at 11:00 a.m. on March 13, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, President Trump issued a proclamation that the COVID-19 outbreak in the United States constitutes a national emergency effective March 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Commissioner of Health has issued a Declaration of Imminent Public Health Threat from COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, I, Donna M. Gayden issued a Declaration of a Local State of Emergency on March 14, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2020 I extended the duration of that Local State of Emergency pursuant to Section 24 of Article 2-B of the New York State Executive Law; and

WHEREAS, I intend on extending the state of emergency pursuant to Section 24 of Article 2-B of the New York State Executive Law because the COVID-19 pandemic continues to threaten the public health and safety of the citizens of Long Beach; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that my March 14, 2020 Declaration of a Local State of Emergency is hereby extended for the earlier period of thirty (30) days from the date of this proclamation or until rescinded by a subsequent order or proclamation.
