CHAPTER XIV

LAWS OF 2022

A LOCAL LAW

AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF LONG
BEACH RE: CITY OFFICERS: THEIR GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES.

BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York as follows:

Sec. 1. Article 3, Section 20.3(a) of the Charter of the City of Long Beach, New York as set forth in Chapter 635 of the Laws of 1922, as heretofore amended, shall be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 20. City Manager

...

3. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of this Charter or any ordinance, the City Council may enter into **written employment agreements with the City Manager, the Corporation Counsel, the City Comptroller, the Police Commissioner and the Commissioner of Public Works** for a term not to exceed three years and upon such terms and conditions as the City Council shall agree.”

Sec. 2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon being filed in the Office of the New York Secretary of State.
