

## Declaration of a Local State of Emergency

Daniel Creighton, City Manager of the City of Long Beach, County of Nassau, State of New York, pursuant to the power vested in him by Section 20 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach and the laws of the State of New York, including Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law to preserve the public safety and render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of Long Beach, hereby exercises that authority and declares as follows:

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2024, a public disturbance of a large crowd of people at Ocean Beach Park and the Long Beach Train Station took place, inclusive of an individual being wounded by gunshot, posing an imminent danger to public transportation, public health, and public safety systems within the City of Long Beach; and

WHEREAS, this significant, dangerous public disturbance is anticipated to continue and pose a threat to the public transportation, public health and public safety of the City of Long Beach; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a Local State of Emergency relative to this public disturbance is declared and exists in the City of Long Beach effective at 12:01 a.m. on June 14, 2024; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this State of Emergency will remain in effect for thirty (30) days, or until rescinded by a subsequent order, whichever occurs first.
