FRIDAY DEADLINE FOR SBA HARDSHIP LETTERS

Remember that the deadline to submit letters of hardship for those who took out an SBA loan post-Sandy is Jan 16th. Those who applied for SBA must submit a letter by this date explaining why repayment would create a hardship or any SBA funds awarded, even if not used, will be considered a duplication of benefits on your NY Rising award.

The Nassau County Bar Association is offering free Legal Consultation Clinics for Nassau residents who are facing foreclosure and for those who are recovering from Superstorm Sandy at the Bar Assn., 15th & West Streets in Mineola, a block south of Old Country Road.
