Dear Mr. Agostisi,

I hereby order that the City of Long Beach Water System must issue an immediate "Boil Water Notice" to all the residents of the that are served by the City of Long Beach Water System in compliance with Subpart 5-1 of the New York State Sanitary Code. This is issued based upon the public water sampling results of June 18<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>.

City of Long Beach is required to issue an immediate Tier I Public Notification "Boil Water Notice" today by 4:00 P.M. that includes a release to major area television and radio broadcasting stations. It is also requested that the public notification notice, which must be approved in advance by this Department, be hand delivered, to all critical consumers. It is required that two consecutive rounds of satisfactory drinking water bacteriological testing results be obtained before the "Boil Water Order" is lifted.
