Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Manager to Enter into a
Contract for On-Call Sewer Maintenance Services with the Lowest
Responsible Bidder.

WHEREAS, after due advertisement therefore, three (3) bids were received in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works on July 25, 2019 for on-call sewer maintenance services to assist the City's Sewer Maintenance Department, which is responsible for providing and maintaining the City's sanitary sewer system, including mains, services, laterals, manholes, storm drains, catch basins and all emergencies;

WHEREAS, said services shall include the identifying of problems, cleaning and inspecting, and to line in-place sewer mains in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, National Water Main Cleaning Co., 1806 Newark Turnpike, Kearny New Jersey 07032 was the lowest responsible bidder at a cost of \$132,061.00, and as this is a requirements contract, total work for this fiscal year will be limited to \$100,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the Acting City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a contract with National Water Main Cleaning Co., 1806 Newark Turnpike, Kearny New Jersey 07032 for on-call sewer maintenance services, at a cost of \$132,061.00, with work for this fiscal year limited to \$100,000.00. Funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 are available in Account No. H2020.52323 (Sewer Main Lining).

The following Resolution was moved by

Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Manager to Enter into
an Agreement with an Annual Marine Construction Contractor.

WHEREAS, after due advertisement therefore, two bids were received in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works on April 19, 2019 for an annual marine construction contractor to make repairs and improvements to bulkheading situated within the boundaries of the City of Long Beach, in accordance with FEMA requirements; and

WHEREAS, said agreement will allow the contractor to make repairs or replacements based upon the extent of the damage to each project site, as well as install tide flex valves; and

WHEREAS, Woodstock Construction Group, 350 Lexington Avenue, Oyster Bay, New York 11771 was the lowest responsible bidder based upon unit prices contained in their submissions, at a cost of \$2,913,065 for a two year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the Acting City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into an agreement with Woodstock Construction Group, 350 Lexington Avenue, Oyster Bay, New York 11771 for an annual marine construction contractor to make repairs and improvements to bulkheading situated within the boundaries of the City of Long Beach, at a cost of \$2,913,065 for a two year period, in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Works, with two (2) one year options to extend at the same terms and conditions. Funds in the amount of \$1,500,000 will be available in fiscal year 2019-2020 in Account No. H1020.53090 (Bulkhead Replacement).

Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Manager to Enter
into Agreements for Auto Body Repair Services for City of
Long Beach Vehicles on an “As Needed” Basis.

WHEREAS, after due advertising therefore, three bids were received in the Office
of the City Purchasing Agent on Thursday, August 22, 2019 at 11:00 a.m., for auto body repair
services for City owned vehicles on an “as needed” basis; and

WHEREAS, the City may make multiple awards for this service and in order to
facilitate repairs in a timely fashion, it is in the City’s best interest to award this service to all
three vendors:

Nationwide Auto Painting, 1850 Atlantic Avenue, Brooklyn, New York 11233-3002;
Artie’s Collision II d/b/a Artkev Corp., 4240 Austin Boulevard, Island Park, New York
11558; and
County Truck & Auto Services, 140 East Merrick Road, Valley Stream, New York
11580;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the
Acting City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into agreements with the above
named vendors for auto body repair services for City owned vehicles, on an “as needed” basis,
for a period of two years with the option to renew for one additional year, at the sole discretion
of the City. Funds are available in Account No. A1640.54499 (Central Garage-Vehicle Repairs).

The following Resolution was moved by
and seconded by :

Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Manager to Enter into
and Renew the Agreement with the Atlantic Beach Fire District.

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has been providing fire-fighting and medical emergency services to the Atlantic Beach Fire District since 1990 and it is the desire of the City and the Atlantic Beach Fire District to enter into and renew the agreement for said services; and

WHEREAS, the Atlantic Beach Fire District has restructured their first response services and has retained a full time paramedic, and as such, the City will be providing fewer services to the District; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to give the District an offset for 50% of the cost of that paramedic, in the amount of \$37,500 per year; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Atlantic Beach Fire District desire to renew said agreement for an additional five years, commencing January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2024, for a total fee of \$482,000 payable at a first year's annual rate of \$133,900, as said amount was adopted in the annual budget in anticipation of the continued agreement, followed by a rate of \$87,025 for the next four years, which equally spreads out the offset difference of \$187,500; and

WHEREAS, there will be an option to renew for an additional five year period at a total fee of \$482,000, payable at a rate of \$96,400 annually;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York that the Acting City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to enter into and renew the agreement with the Atlantic Beach Fire District for a period of five years, commencing January 1, 2020 for a total fee of \$482,000 payable at a first year's annual rate of \$133,900, followed by a rate of \$87,025 for the next four years, with an option to renew for an additional five year period for a total fee of \$482,000, payable at an annual rate of \$96,400; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said agreement shall contain such other terms, conditions and provisions as the Acting City Manager shall deem proper.

ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH RE: WATER AND WATER
DISTRIBUTION.

BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Long Beach, New York, as follows:

Sec.1. Chapter 25, Article II, Division 2, Section 25-26 (a)(2) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Long Beach, as heretofore amended, shall be and the same is hereby amended, to read as follows:

“Sec. 25-26. Water charges and sewer rents.

(a) *Water rates:*

...

(2) A minimum charge per quarter will be based on twelve thousand (12,000) gallons and a fee of **fifty four dollars (\$54.00).**”

...

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
