Bulk Pickup Guidelines



Bulk items generally consist of large and/or heavy items as well as anything metal.
Items cannot be placed curbside until a bulk pickup appointment is scheduled.

<p>To Schedule a Bulk Pickup:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Call Sanitation at (516) 432-3132, or 2) Submit a service request through the LBNY Mobile App 	<p>Bulk Pickup Days:</p> <p>East End: Monday & Thursday West End: Tuesday & Friday</p>
<p>Proper Setout</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Place bulk items curbside <i>no earlier</i> than the evening prior to your scheduled collection and <i>no later</i> than 7am the day of your scheduled collection. • Do not block foot traffic or place items in the street 	
<p>EXAMPLES OF ALLOWED ITEMS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Large and/or heavy items ✓ Metal/Home Appliances (<i>i.e. washers, dryers, A/C units, water heaters, furnaces, microwaves, etc.</i>) ✓ Couches/Tables/Chairs/Patio Furniture ✓ File cabinets ✓ Box springs and bed frames ✓ Mattresses (<i>*must be wrapped in plastic</i>) ✓ Sofa Beds (<i>*mattress must be removed and wrapped in plastic</i>) ✓ Wood/Carpet (<i>must be cut to at least 4 foot pieces</i>) ✓ Large electronics (<i>anything larger than x by y</i>) <p><i>*Plastic wrap can be purchased online or at your local home improvement store. Plastic wrap protects the mattress from getting soiled by rain, snow, or dirt. If a mattress is soiled, it will be rejected by our recycling vendor and is 20 times more expensive for the City to dispose of.</i></p>	
<p>NOT ALLOWED:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Construction debris ✗ Tires (<i>dispose through STOP program</i>) ✗ Hazardous Materials (<i>dispose through STOP program</i>) 	<p>SPECIAL ITEMS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refrigerators/Freezers (<i>Recycle these through PSEG utility and earn \$50. Learn more at longbeachny.gov/sanitation</i>)
<p>Take Back Programs</p> <p>Please help us lessen the financial burden on the City by asking your mattress, furniture, or home appliance company if they offer a free “take-back program” before scheduling a bulk pickup. You could also contact Goodwill, the Salvation Army, or Habitat for Humanity to research their donation acceptance policy.</p>
